

Announcement of CFOT Research Grants and Seed Money Opportunities

The CFOT Research Advisory Committee announces the availability of funding for 2021 to members of OTAC.

Research Grants

Awards for **research grants** are available for up to \$7,000.00 to practicing occupational therapy practitioners (licensed in California) including academicians and post entry-level students engaged in independent doctoral level research. These requests can be used to help fund items such as equipment, consultation fees, printing, postage, communications, and supplies used for individual research. Research funds may only be awarded to an individual, not an organization, in order to avoid overhead costs. Applicants are advised that no indirect costs may be allocated to an institution. In addition applicant's salaries are not reimbursable through these funds. Priority is given to occupational therapy outcome studies.

Research grants will be awarded once each year at the CFOT Luncheon during the annual OTAC Conference. Grant requests must be submitted on or before **June 15th** each year.

Seed Money: Research Projects and Program Development Projects

Up to \$250.00 (per request) in **"seed" money** awarded to practicing occupational therapy practitioners and OT or OTA students to help fund items such as equipment, consultation fees, printing, postage, communications, and supplies used for research **or** program development projects that address occupational therapy practice.

Seed money will be distributed four times per year. Requests are reviewed quarterly and can be submitted throughout the year. <u>No</u> seed money <u>request is too small</u>!
