 OTAC's financial position is strong. There was an increase in total assets from the previous year, building on the continued pattern. OTAC's 2015-2016 fiscal year had a positive net income.

 - a. Chuck Strauch, previous Executive Director for OTAC, was honored. California Foundation for Occupational Therapy (CFOT) announced the Chuck Strauch Scholarship this year.
 - b. Three practitioners were recognized for Honorary Lifetime Memberships:

 - iii. Judi Palladino
 - c. The OTAC revised Strategic Plan and Core Values were shared. The Core Values remained the same because they continue to be applicable and powerful.
 - d. One of the president's goals is to build unity within the state, particularly with other ally organizations, such as the California Board for Occupational Therapy (CBOT) and the California Fieldwork Council (CFC).
 - i. Engaged in collaboration with both CBOT and CFC around providing professional development units (PDUs) for Level I Fieldwork Educators.
 - ii. Up to 50% of PDUs can now come from serving as an FW Educator.
 - e. The vision for 2017 kicks off with the Rose Parade, which has been a six-year endeavor. The OT Centennial float will start off a year-long publicity campaign called "100 Stories for 100 Years."




